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Remanufactured Transmission Replacement

Under the terms of the Golden Rule warranty a “repairing” shop is only obligated to remove the failed transmission and replace it with a unit provided by the original shop or a “qualified” remanufactured unit that the original shop has negotiated fully and made deliverable to the repairing shop. Under these terms the repairing shop is entitled to the Golden Rule rate (as listed on page 1 of the Estimator Sheet). The repairing shop shall be paid for their R&R services (listed on page 1 of the Estimator sheet) by the original shop. In the event that the remanufacturer’s rate is less than the Golden Rule rate, the original shop will make up the difference. In this event the repairing shop must fill out the estimator sheet with their R&R hours and rate and submit it to the original shop for authorization and payment.

Exception

Many remanufacturer’s prefer working directly with the repairing shop. This is perfectly acceptable provided that the original shop and repairing shop agree to this. It is accepted that the terms of the warranty and conditions for replacing or repairing a remanufactured transmission is determined by the remanufacturer. Should the remanufacturer and repairing shop agree to work together it then relinquishes any further responsibility of the original shop for completing the warranty repairs. However, this does not release the original shop from their obligations to their customer for the remainder of the Golden Rule warranty term.
